The season 2017/2018 was very beautiful because I used to train with the first team for months therefore I realized for the first time that becoming a footballer could really be my job.

In the season of 2018/2019 Bologna FC sent me on loan to Carpi FC, which had been really interested in my football profile for a couple of years, where I used to train with the first team during the week and play the match with the youth team in the weekend.

Unfortunately at the end of the season I broke my knee and I had to get operated (left meniscus). After few months, when I recovered from the operation, I restarted playing in the Italian fourth League, a really tough championship that is considered as a professional championship in Italy.

I've been playing in that competition for 3 years now with several teams scattered throughout Italy and I would define this period as an amazing adventure because I learnt and grew up a lot both as a person and as a footballer in a first team championship.

Unfortunately in this category I felt like the system is not fully meritocratic.

In this moment I would like to try a new football experience where the only reasons that matter are how good I am as a goalkeeper.

Currently I am a free agent, and I would like to come to Denmark because I know I will certainly have the opportunity to compete and show my value hoping that one day I will eventually return in the highest leagues.

There's another reason that I would like to play in Denmark, my mother is Danish and I would like to learn my second homeland language better and getting to know better Denmark culture and traditions.

I was born in Bologna but almost all my life I have been living in the countryside together with my parents and my big brother. I like nature and when I have time I go fishing and cooking it, I have a lot of hobbies and one of these is playing chess. I have been spending my summer holidays in Denmark ever since I was born visiting my grandparents and my uncles.
