- during the very first transfer window I built the team (as vast majority of first team players were from my recommendation) that already <u>in the first season</u> totally dominated the league (secured the promotion to top division 4 weeks before the season's end) and performed magnificently in Polish Cup (eliminating among others both Lech Poznań and Legia Warsaw, lost finally in the semi-final) and had an incredible streak of 27 consecutive official games undefeated!

- scouted, recommended and signed 10 players: <u>Michał Gliwa</u>, <u>Petr Schwarz</u>, <u>Sebastian Musiolik</u>, <u>Arkadiusz Kasperkiewicz</u>, <u>Marcin Listkowski</u>, <u>Patryk Kun</u>, <u>Daniel</u> <u>Bartl</u>, <u>Jakub Apolinarski</u>, <u>Chidiebere Nwakali</u> and <u>Patrick Friday Eze</u> – all of them apart from Nigerians were decided by the club to stay for the coming season in Ekstraklasa (1st tier) although they were contracted for 2nd tier only...
- resigned from cooperation with the club due to:
 - discrepant visions of the development of the club against the owner
 - lack of investment in sporting department and no willingness to invest in
 - modern analytics tools and scouting network
 - lack of investment in other departments of the club
 - delays with the stadium redevelopment, risk of being not licenced for the top flight for next season, etc.

2017 <u>As Sporting Director for Piast Gliwice (1st tier)</u>:

- helped the club to survive the critical moment (both financially and from a sporting perspective):

the club avoided relegation - from 16th position (last one in the league) while appointed, to 10th position at the end of the season 2016/2017
during only one summer transfer window I generated players' sales profit more than two times higher than summarised profits of the club during 10 (sic!) previous transfer windows, which along with the wages limitations accounted for more than 25% of the club's yearly budget and built the surplus exploited by my successors

- initialized extensive restructuring of the club's sporting department, including hiring 8 new specialists in different fields (apart from 1 headhunted by another club, all of them work in the club until now),

 without any money on transfer fees (0 PLN) scouted and contracted for the club:
 <u>Joel Valencia</u> (b. 1995, from FC Koper - team relegated from Slovenian 1st tier, salary budget and expected role: rotation player, contract: 1+3 club only option) – has been awarded with the <u>Best Player of the Season</u> <u>2018/2019 in Poland Award</u> lately, <u>sold to Brentford for more than €2,000,000</u>;



2017 – Valencia signed for free 2019 – Player of the Season, €2M move to Brentford

- <u>Martin Konczkowski</u> (b. 1993, from Ruch Chorzów – team relegated from Polish 1st tier, salary budget and expected role: rotation player, contract: 3+2 club only option, in 2018/2019 nominated to the player of the month trophy twice, 8 assists),

- initialization and finalisation of extension of the contract with more than a year ahead its conclusion with <u>Radosław Murawski</u> (new contract: 4 years), afterwards he was sold to **Palermo SC** for nice money thanks to the extension,

- initialization and finalisation of signing 5-year contract with <u>Patryk Dziczek</u> from Reserve Team (contract: 3+2 club only option, now starting eleven player for Poland U21 National Team) – after the sale of Murawski there was **the place in the team left for Dziczek (no player signed for this position)** – has been awarded the <u>Young Player</u> <u>of the Season 2018/2019 Award</u> lately and sold to Lazio Rome for €2M soon after that.
